**November 2021** Community Service received 19 containers of fabric from Dale Storey of Oregon House.

**December 2021** 51 quilts given to Foster Care

## VALLEY QUILT GUILD BOARD MEETING

**April 11, 2022**

**Date:** April 11, 2022

**Call to Order:** A Meeting of the Valley Quilt Guild Board was held on April 11, 2022 at the Crossroads Community Church. It was called to order at 4:07 pm.

**Secretary:** A motion to approve the minutes of the March meeting as written was made by Linda Matsumoto and seconded by Diane Leighton. A unanimous vote to approve followed.

**Correspondence:** The Guild received numerous thank you notes from people who received quilts after losing homes in the Dixie fire. These notes will be at the hospitality table at the April meeting for anyone who would like to read them.

**Treasurer:** We have a Checking balance of \$2,284.63 and a Savings balance of \$11,945.32. The Quilt Show balance is \$16,639.32 making our combined total \$30,869.27.

**Discussion of Quilt Show Income** – There was some discussion clarifying the \$5,000 Quilt Show income in the current budget. No changes were recommended.

### Old Business

**Meeting Venues** – April, May and June meetings are scheduled at Gray Avenue Church. There is a possibility of meetings moving back to the Cal Trans building in July. Carleen Hagen will keep us apprised of the situation. Colleen will look into booking the Presbyterian Church for the August Ice Cream Social.

**Nominating Committee Report-** We have volunteers to be on the slate for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice-President, and people considering being on the slate for Secretary and President. We are still in need of a volunteer to run for Treasurer.

**Purchase of new drape and pole system for hanging quilts at the quilt show** – There is an interest in doing this, but after some discussion, the item was tabled until next month when we have more information. It was discussed to possibly use the proceeds from the fall auction to gradually finance the new system.
