The Holiday Season has now passed and it's time to start thinking about your Quilt Show entries. Our 2015 Quilt Show "Not Your Grandma's Quilt" will be held on March 21 & 22, 2015. We will have Rules of Entry and Quilt Show Entry Forms for both Regular (Non-Judged) and Judged Entries (printed in RED) available at our table, so please stop by at the meeting and pick yours up. Please bring remember to bring your Quilt information, fabric swatches, and photos to complete your entries.

Think about having your entry judged this year. It's a great learning experience for any quilter.

Things to Remember:

- All entries must have a completed Regular Entry form.
- Accurate measurements.
- Fabric swatches.
- Photos.
- You must be a VQG Member to enter. (Please encourage anyone who wishes to enter to join the Guild).
- The entries per person are limited to 5. However, if you have an additional wonderful quilt and wish to show it, please let us know.

Judges Entries:

- Judged Entries ONLY require a \$5.00 fee.
- You MUST complete 2 Entry Application if your entry is being Judged. (Regular Entry Form & a Judged Entry Form).
- Judged Entries ONLY must be turned in for judging on 3/19/15.

Helpful Hints from Alyce

A special hint to all ~ Happy New Year and be sure to take time each day to sew a stitch or two on a favorite UFO!

Launder your fabric to preshrink it and remove any finishes that prevent fusibles from adhering. Always test a swatch of fusible interfacing before using it in a project. Iron temp can vary. Use a press cloth, if needed.

If fusible material is on the ironing board cover, try putting a sheet of aluminum foil on

top and pressing over the area. Use a dry hot iron (no steam). Most of the time the residue will adhere to the foil.

QUIP's = Quilts Unfinished In Progress. A tongue twister after so many UFO's!

Things to Remember:

- ~ All entries must have a completed Regular Entry form.
- ~ Accurate measurements.
- ~ Fabric swatches.
- ~ Photos.
- ~ You must be a VQG Member to enter. (Please encourage anyone who wishes to enter to join the Guild).

~ The entries per person are limited to 5. However, if you have an additional wonderful quilt and wish to show it, please let us know.

Judges Entries:

- ~ Judged Entries ONLY require a \$5.00 fee.
- ~ You MUST complete 2 Entry Application if your entry is being Judged. (Regular Entry Form & a Judged Entry Form).
- ~ Judged Entries ONLY must be turned in for judging on 3/19/15.
- ~ Division Class Definitions have changed this year so please be sure to use the new entry form for Judged Entries.
- ~ Division Class sizes: XXX-LARGE over 300 inches; XX-LARGE -276 to 299 inches; X-LARGE – 226 to 275

inches; LARGE - 201 to 225 inches; MEDIUM – 151 to 200 inches; SMALL – up to 150 inches.

~ Please see Judged Entry Instructions for Class Definitions.

Board Meeting Minutes

VALLEY QUILT GUILD BOARD MEETING January 14, 2015

MEMBERS PRESENT: Cooky Amarel, Claire Poole, Cheryl Gaines, Wendy Cockrell, Linda Matsumoto, Margaret Brazelton, Dee Jagerhorn, Carleen Hagen, Nancy Wilson, Kim Buzolich, Pat May, Sharon Easter, Jody Ohrt, Joann Thomas, and Ginger Benham.

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 12:06 pm by President Cooky Amarel.

SECRETARY:

A motion was made and seconded (Cockrell/Gaines) and unanimously voted to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the November 12, 2014 Board Meeting. A motion was made and seconded (Jagerhorn/Gaines) and unanimously voted to approve the minutes as written. A letter was received from the Yuba Sutter Fair thanking us for our sponsorship for the 2014 Fair. They also announced the theme for this year's fair is "Where fun Grows", to be held July 30-August 2, 2015. Three thank you notes were received by Dee Jagerhorn for Community Service items from Shriner's Hospital for wheelchair bags, Women's Circle for baby quilts, and from Catherine Post, a terminally ill cancer patient.

TREASURER:

The checking accounting has a balance of \$9,412.96 and the savings account has a balance of \$16,060.79. These figures reflect the payment of the 2014 State Sales Tax.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

A discussion was held on the great Christmas party in December, with a big thank you to Carolyn McCray and Wanda Horn for chairing it and to Joann Thomas for the wonderful decorations. Everyone enjoyed the food and the service also. Carleen will reserve Whitaker Hall for this year's party in December.

Sharon noted that the budget for NCQC is short this year and a motion was made and seconded (Matsumoto/Jagerhorn) and unanimously voted to increase this year's budget by \$5.

A motion was made and seconded (N.Wilson/Jagerhorn) and unanimously voted to increase the Property budget by \$150 to cover items needed for the Quilt Show.

Jody will explore a new vendor to order 310 Club Pins and Past President Pins.

Cooky will investigate getting an additional small storage space to house the Guild's archival records.

NEW BUSINESS:

Cooky announced we may lose the ability to use the office space we are using for our monthly Board meetings. She has a lead for space in a nearby complex that we will be able to use at no cost to the Guild.

The Guild's policies were discussed. Any issue brought before a Board member that may affect a Guild policy should be addressed and voted upon by the Board.

Each Board and Committee member was asked to provide Cooky with a list of dates/months that are pertinent to their position (i.e. deadlines for voting, program schedules, quilt show entries). A calendar will be prepared that shows key dates for Guild members.

Claire and Cheryl reported on the Newcomer's Meeting that will be held at the Courthouse Café prior to the January General Meeting on January 28. They encouraged all Board and Committee Chairpersons to attend to help answer questions about their positions and functions within the Guild. The dinner will begin at 4:45 pm and reservations are mandatory. A separate e-mail will go out for reservations.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:27 p.m.




