machine. If yours is like mine it's time for a good cleaning and oiling. DeRay knows all the ins and outs, so don't miss a great class.


March can you believe we are already talking Quilt Show wrap up. Yes, it's here. So the March meeting is everything Quilt Show Wrap UP.

### Quilt Show Entries

Last call for Quilt Show Entries – Members...The January 27th General Meeting is the last day to accept entries for our 2016 Quilt Show, "Adventures in Quilting" which will be held on March 19 & 20, 2016. We will have Rules of Entry and Quilt Show Entry Forms for both Regular (Non-Judged) and Judged Entries (printed in RED) available at our table, so please stop by at the meeting and pick yours up. Think about having your entry judged this year. It's a great learning experience for any quilter. If you don't have entry forms already please bring the following information and items to the General Meeting and you can complete it that night.

#### Things to Remember:

- · All entries must have a completed Regular Entry form.
- · Accurate measurements.
- · Fabric swatches.
- Photos.
- You must be a VQG Member to enter. (Please encourage anyone who wishes to enter to join the Guild).
- The entries per person are limited to 5. However, if you have an additional wonderful quilt and wish to show it, please let us know.

#### **Judges Entries:**

- · Judged Entries ONLY require a \$5.00 fee.
- You MUST complete 2 Entry Application if your entry is being Judged. (Regular Entry Form & a Judged Entry Form).
- Judged Entries ONLY must be turned in for judging on Thursday 3/17/16.

#### **Important Dates to Remember:**

- Last Date to accept entry applications VQG January General Meeting, Wednesday, 1/27/16.
- Entry Numbers will be handed out at the VQG February General Meeting on 2/24/16. (The Entry # is assigned to your quilt/article and needs to be placed on your quilt/article. This card needs to be saved as it is your receipt to pick up your quilt/article at the end of the show).
- **Delivery** Your quilt/article must be delivered to the Yuba Sutter Fairground on Friday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2016 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and are to arrive no later than 10:00 a.m.
- Pickup Quilts must be picked up on Sunday, March 20<sup>nd</sup>, 2016 after the show from 5-5:30 p.m. Bring your Card/Receipt to claim your quilt/entry.

Just a reminder to all our members, please make the effort to submit at least 1 entry for the show. Looking forward to another wonderful Quilt Show ..."Adventures in Quilting", March 19<sup>st</sup> & 20<sup>nd</sup> 2016.



### Board Meeting Minutes

#### VALLEY QUILT GUILD BOARD MEETING January 13, 2016

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Cooky Amarel, Cheryl Gaines, Claire Poole, Linda Matsumoto, Margaret Rehermann, DeRay Jensen, Delaina Watson, Diane Steele, Carleen Hagen, Diane Leighton, Kim Buzolich, Pat May, Diana Tatro, Joann Thomas, Dee Jagerhorn, Ginger Benham, and Jody Ohrt.

**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order at 12:00 noon by President Cooky Amarel.

SECRETARY: A motion was made and seconded (Leighton/Steele) and unanimously voted to dispense with the reading of the minutes of November 11, 2015 Board Meeting. A motion was made and seconded (Watson/Steele) and unanimously voted to approve the minutes as written. A letter was read from Hands of Hope, thanking the Guild for the donation of socks at Christmastime.

**TREASURER:** The checking account has a balance of \$9,633.93 and the savings account has a balance of \$16,064.97. A motion was made and seconded (D.Jensen/Jagerhorn) and unanimously voted to approve a new line item in the Budget for "Special Projects". The line item will be used as an "in and out" accounting method for the quilting of approximately 30 quilts for Casa de Esperanza. The quilts were pieced and donated by Guild member. The quilting costs are being underwritten by donations to Casa and will be run through our account at no expense to the Guild.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**: Cooky thanked the Board for hosting the Christmas Party. The food was great and the basket raffle earned \$730.

Pat May has more forms for Quilt Show entries. Remember the last date for entries is the January 27, 2016 General Meeting.

The Board has previously made a decision to have the completed quilts from the Blocks of the Quarter shown at the January General Meeting to see which ones should be entered in the Show. After the display of completed quilts showed such individuality and creativity, it is felt that multiple entries of the quilts is not a problem and have rescinded that earlier decision. All entries are welcome for the Show.

**NEW BUSINESS**: The April and July General Meetings will NOT BE HELD AT CALTRANS due to prior commitments. A motion was made and seconded (Matsumoto/Jagerhorn) and unanimously voted to hold those two meetings at St. Andrews Church in Yuba City. Diane Leighton has made arrangements with the Church for us to meet there.

Per the By-Laws, a By-Law Committee will review those laws every two years. A Committee will meet this month to review the By-Laws, Policies and Procedures and Job Duties of the Guild.

A Nominating Committee survey will be printed in the January and February newsletters to allow members to anonymously suggest names for submission for the slate of officer for the next Guild election. A box will be located at the reception desk at the meetings to collect the anonymous survey forms. Cooky asked for volunteers to act as the Nominating Committee.





# Block of the month






Fabris - muslin Darb Red Light Red

"4" seam allowed. after each step press seams to one side (towards dark frint if possible). Lay preses out as they will be sewn. Sew triangles together first to make agreement. Sew the squares into rows. Sew rows together. Block should measure 12/2" if assembled accurately. Check parinted templates for rariance due to printing

### Shirley needs your help. . .


