Additional information regarding virtual quilt show 2021:

- 1. We are still doing this year's challenge quilts. We will show them at the January meeting, and vote on them afterwards using google forms like we have before. I think the plan is to physically show the challenge quilts from 2020, 2021, and 2022 at the 2022 show ... so keep track of them. If you have a challenge quilt to enter, you need to send Dee Jagerhorn and me (Colleen) a picture of your quilt and the letter you were assigned by 8 pm on Tuesday, January 26. You can email it, text it, or if you need me to come take a picture of it for you, you can call me. That's nine days ... there is still time to make one.
- 2. We are still having the drawing for the opportunity quilt on March 14, 2021. If you have not yet turned in money and stubs from the tickets you sold (or bought yourself) you can contact me, and I will pick them up, you can drop them off at Eileen Milligan's, or you can take them directly to Thea Norum. Just contact first before you drop off.
- **3. The show itself will be virtual again.** The number of quilts in the show is totally up to members. I'm hoping you will take pictures of the quilts you would have entered, up to 5 quilts, and send them to me. If you have some amazing features or quilting on your quilt and want to send a close-up shot as well, please do so. When you send me the picture, also send the following information.

The good news is your quilt does not need to have a sleeve.

A meeting of the **Valley Quilt Guild Board** was held on January 11, 2021. It was an online meeting using the ZOOM application since the pandemic quarantine is still in effect. It was called to order at 11:03 a.m.

Secretary: A motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting was made by Linda Matsumoto and seconded by Eileen Milligan. A unanimous vote followed.

Treasurer: We have a checking balance of \$6,524.64 and a savings balance of \$14,138.45. All except \$4,000 will be moved to savings.

Old Business: Virtual Christmas Party Wrap-Up: There were four winners of the cookie decoration contest: Shirley Taylor, Shirley Mills, Eileen Milligan and Betty Harris.


Quilt Show Entries: Colleen Pelfrey and Sandra Torres are still trying to create an online entry form. Janet requested vouchers be put on Bublup.

Rally-Up Online Auction: Our first Rally-Up auction went better than we expected. We made \$4,148.78 plus donations. Thank you to everyone who helped make this a reality.

Let It Go: This event is still on the shelf.

Explore Yuba-Sutter: We were notified by the Appeal-Democrat that they would not be publishing due to lack of entries.

New Business: Spring Rally Up Auction: This discussion was tabled for a later meeting.

Quilt Show: Possible alternatives to the Quilt Show were offered by Deanne Williams: 1 - Do nothing but another Auction; 2 - Change the date; 3 - Have a mini quilt show with no food or very few vendors, possibly outdoors; 4 - Just have a quilt judging with the results posted online.

For the virtual quilt show submit 1 or 2 quilts with descriptions to Colleen and she will put together a slide show. Contact Colleen for details if you are interested.

Diane Leighton will return all the vendors deposits.

It was discussed that we would display all our previous windsocks and challenge quilts from the 2020 and 2021 shows, when we are able to have a physical show .

Vice President's Update: Colleen Pelfrey and Eileen Milligan will be this month's speakers and Sandy Corbin is scheduled for next month. Karen Davis' daughter-in-law may give a short lecture on current phone scams to help our members avoid being taken advantage of. Michelle Jones will be filling the speakers schedule a month at a time during the pandemic. We will be sticking to Sew Days rather than workshops, as well.

Community Service: There are currently a lot of quilts being bound.

Opportunity Quilt: We have currently raised \$3,145.00 through our members, \$1027.00 through quilt shops, etc., for a total of \$4,172.00. You guys are amazing!

Membership: There are 124 members and 7 affiliates.

- **Quilt Show Challenge Quilts:** The Challenge Quilts will be shared at the January meeting, and a google form link will be emailed to everyone for voting.
- **UFO's:** The Sew Day on January 16, 2021 will be a time to catch up on UFO's, but otherwise UFO's are tabled until we meet in person.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 12:08 p.m.
