

VALLEY QUILT GUILD BOARD MEETING

July, 2021

- A meeting of the **Valley Quilt Guild Board** was held on July 12, 2021, at the Crossroads Community Church. It was called to order at 4:00 p.m.
- **Secretary:** A motion to approve the corrected minutes of the last meeting was made by Cooky Amarel and seconded by Eileen Milligan. A unanimous vote to approve followed.
- **Treasurer:** We have a checking balance of \$2,188.54 and a savings balance of \$19,999.95; there is a Quilt Show balance of \$5,090.30 for a combined total of \$27,278.79.
- **Old Business: Fair Wrap Up** Closing an hour early was extremely helpful and we would like to continue that next year. The pickup day needs to have better security.

July meeting/Ice cream social: The social will be held live at St. Andrew Church (1390 Franklin Rd., Yuba City) on July 28 at 6 pm. There will be many door prizes, and everyone will receive 4 tickets to place in the prize bags. Sandra Torres has made goodie bags for the tables and if you would like to help with set up, please feel free to come as early as 5 pm. We will not be having the Let It Go Event at this time. We just want to focus on our first meeting in person. There are currently 73 RSVP's and 2 maybes.

Christmas Party: We will be having the party on Thursday, December 2, 2021, at the Moose Hall (205 S. Walton Avenue, Yuba City). There is a \$400 deposit, and we will get \$100 back if we clean up ourselves. There is no dessert served so we discussed the possibility of purchasing pies and cakes. The meal will be a choice of Turkey or Roast Beef with sides and a salad. We will be extending an invitation to both Villla Rosa and Sew-n-Piece to be vendors at the event.

Donation to Nevada: The discussion of donating fidget quilts to an organization in Nevada in order to be able to qualify for a Non-profit vendors license in that State was tabled until next meeting.

Minutes continued...

General Meetings: Both the August meeting and the Linda Ballard class are confirmed for Gray Avenue Church. A donation of \$150 to Gray Avenue Church for the use of the facilities for the Linda Ballard Class and another \$150 for the use of facilities for the August General meeting will be included in the proposed budget at the August board meeting and voted on then.

New Business: One Month Budget: \$60 was added to the insurance figure. The new adjustment for insurance is \$2,061.00. Linda Matsumoto made a motion to accept the budget with the adjustment and Cooky Amarel seconded. A unanimous vote followed.

Paradise Chocolate Festival: Deanna would like to take the Opportunity Quilt to the festival on September 18. A booth rental is \$40. Diane Leighton made a motion to rent the booth and Pat Smith seconded. A unanimous vote followed.

Online Auction in November: Colleen is willing to put together another online auction for November. Deanna Williams made a motion to have the auction and Diane Leighton seconded. A unanimous vote followed.

- **Vice President Update:** Linda Ballard will be teaching a class on August 28 at Gray Avenue Church. The fee for the class is \$30 and 8 members are signed up. Eileen Milligan has information on this class. Yvonne Phenicie will be the live speaker for August.
- **Community Service Quilts:** Diane Leighton will be presenting the next round of Quilts to the Foster care program during our August meeting.
- **Opportunity Quilt 2022:** Deanna Williams has three dates scheduled for August and one for September. Guilds are beginning to open up for live meetings and the goal is to get the quilt to those meetings.

Membership: We have 57 returning, 7 new and 3 affiliate members so far, for a total of 67 members. If you need the form, it is available on our website's first page on the far-right hand column.
