Quilt Show Judging Day

Quilt Show Judging day is Thursday, March 17, 2016. To all of you that are having your quilts judged I say a big THANK YOU. We are having 73 quilts judged this year. The total of the entry fees will pay the judges fee with some left over. First time ever!!!!!

Thursday March 17, 2016 is judging day. Please bring your quilts to be judged to the fairgrounds for check in between the hours of 8:30 am and 9:30 am. Any guilts not being judged should be delivered to the fairgrounds on Friday morning. Remember to have your label sewn on to the back (back of quilt facing you - label in bottom left corner) and the quilt folded with the label showing.



Judging will begin at 10:00 am. All guild members are invited to observe the judging. We will have a seating area for you. You do not have to stay all day, however, you are welcome to.

Beth Foust is our judge this year. Beth graduated from the West Coast Quilt Judging Academy in 2012. She is currently serving as the Assistant Director of NCQC and is a member of the Foothill Quilters Guild.

Quilt Show Entries

Quilt Show Entries – Members...We have 228 entries and Quilt Show Layout has been done. Your Entry numbers and fabric labels are ready to be picked up at the February 24th, General Meeting. Please stop by the table and pick up your Entry Numbers/Receipt 4" x 6" cards. Please keep this card in a safe place, it is needed to claim your entry/quilt at the end of the show. If you do not wish to use fabric labels, additional paper labels will be available at our table.

Things to Remember:

- Each entry requires a paper or fabric label sewn as follows:
- With the back of the quilt facing you, sew or baste the label in the lower left hand corner. (With the quilt facing you, it ends up being on the back of the quilt, in the lower right hand corner).
- Quilt entries over 36" require a 4" hanging sleeve sewn to the back top edge of the quilt.
- Exception Entry #'s 98 thru 139 will not require sleeves as they will be hung on the Baby Frames pinned to sheets. Please refer to Rules of Entry for instructions for instructions on how to make a hanging sleeve.
- When turning in your entry, please be sure it is folded with label side up and showing. (This speeds up check in time.)
 - **Picking up quilts after the show**. We try to start handing out quilts promptly at 5 p.m. The floor must be cleared and all quilts/entries must be accounted for and placed in order. All hands are needed, so please see the take down committee for instructions after the show to help. We do give out number for members who are waiting for their quilts, so your place is not lost in line.

Important Dates to Remember:


Judged Entries ONLY!!!! Must be delivered to the Yuba Sutter Fairground on Thursday, March 17th, 2016 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.

- **Delivery** Your quilt/article must be delivered to the Yuba Sutter Fairground on Friday, March 18th, 2016 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and are to arrive no later than 10:00 a.m.
- Pickup Quilts must be picked up on Sunday, March 20th after the show from 5-5:30 p.m. Bring your Card/Receipt to claim your quilt/entry.

Board Meeting Minutes

VALLEY QUILT GUILD BOARD MEETING

March 9, 2016

MEMBERS PRESENT: Cooky Amarel, Cheryl Gaines, Claire Poole, Wendy Cockrell, Linda Matsumoto, Margaret Rehermann, DeRay Jensen, Dee Jagerhorn, Carleen Hagen, Diane Leighton, Nancy Wilson, Valerie Wilson, Kim Buzolich, Pat May, Diana Tatro, Nicki Lura, Shirley Jensen, and Sharon Easter.

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 12:02 pm by President Cooky Amarel.

SECRETARY: A motion was made and seconded (D.Jensen/May) and unanimously voted to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the February 10, 2016 Board Meeting. A motion was made and seconded (Leighton/D.Jensen) and unanimously voted to accept the minutes as written with the correction under "Quilt Show" stating that the Board unanimously voted to discontinue providing "after hours professional" security during the Show.

A note was sent to Pat Fryer of Villa Rosa Designs thanking her for the generous donation of two quilts for our Community Service projects.

TREASURER: The checking account has a balance of \$8,409.34 and the savings account has a balance of \$16,064.97.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Cooky asked that all members remember that the April General Meeting will be held at St. Andrew Presbyterian Church. Kim will send out an e-mail reminding the members a few days before that meeting.

DeRay reported that he has talked to the 20-30 Club and they are not able to change the weekend of their 2017 BrewFest at the Fairgrounds but will be able to change in 2018 and 2019. The Valley Quilt Guild will host our 2017 Show on the third weekend in March of that year, but will host the 2018 and 2019 shows on the second weekend in March.

There was no new information on the Guild's bank charges.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Guild indirectly received a request from another Guild to market their Opportunity Quilt in our monthly newsletter. It was agreed that no action was needed and that the Guild cannot provide free advertisement in the Guild Newsletter.

There were no nominations for Life Memberships submitted for this year.

A discussion was held about the Guild's need for new members. The annual Quilt Show is a great time to solicit new members and we will make sure there are membership forms at the Information Desk at the Show.

The Nominating Committee has not had any persons agree to run for office yet. The slate of officers needs to be presented at the April General Meeting to be voted upon at the May General Meeting.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

The recent Guild classes have exhibited a positive cash flow.

QUILT SHOW:

There is no meeting tonight. After some discussion it was decided that we did not need to make any cash box changes at the Entrance Desk for this years show. The cash will be handled by the Show's Treasurer in the same manner as it was last year. The quilt show signs have been delivered and most of them have been installed. The demonstration schedule has been filled for both days. Wendy showed the tri-fold color program and has sent the order to the printer. She also has purchased a 36"x48" laminated board for use in the Information Booth for the hourly drawings. It was motioned and seconded (Matsumoto/Jagerhorn) and unanimously voted to increase the Guild's Property Budget to cover the cost of purchasing permanent reusable Quilt Show signs.

Use the appropriate needle the number of the thread, the for the size of the thread, such as a thicker it is. 70/10 for 60-weight thread and size 80/12 for 30 or 40 weight thread.

Seam allowances pressed in the wrong direction make it more difficult to quilt. So double Remember that the smaller check the way seams should lay.

Save the long strips of fabric for tying up stems of plants in the garden. Brightens it up and is a reminder of projects you have finished.


