Board Meeting Minutes

VALLEY QUILT GUILD BOARD MEETING March 14, 2022

Location: Crossroads Community Church

Date: March 14, 2022

Attendees: Colleen Pelfrey, President, Pat Smith, 2nd Vice-President, Eileen Milligan, Co-Secretary, Jan A Thompson, Treasurer, Deanna Williams, 2022 Quilt Show Chairman, Barbara Buehrle, Quilt Show Treasurer, Diane Leighton, Community Service, Nicki Lura, Membership, Sharon Easter, NCQC & QGNQ Representative, and Linda Matsumoto, Sunshine.

Call to Order: A Meeting of the Valley Quilt Guild Board was held on March 14, 2022 at the Crossroads Community Church. It was called to order at 4:01 pm.

Secretary: A motion to approve the minutes of the February meeting as written was made by Deanna Williams and seconded by Linda Matsumoto. A unanimous vote to approve followed.

Correspondence: Colleen received a book from Beale Air Force Base with numerous pictures from their Christmas Party and a heartfelt thank you. Colleen will bring it to the March meeting to share at the hospitality table.

Treasurer: We have a checking balance of \$2,544.23 and a savings balance of \$11,943.55. The Quilt Show balance is \$5,904.21 making our combined total \$20,391.99.

Old Business:

Meeting Venues – March, April & May meetings are scheduled at Gray Avenue Church.

New Member Info - Colleen has updated the pamphlet for new and possible new members. They were available at the quilt show and Colleen will make sure Nicki Lura and Viv at Sew-n-Piece have them. The possibility of pairing a new member with a vintage member was revisited. Colleen had no response to her query so it was agreed amongst us that should someone feel the need, the board members present were all fine with being asked to show a new member around.

New Business:

Appointment of Nominating Committee – The nominees will be presented at the April meeting with a call for nominations from the floor. Pat Smith volunteered to be the board member on the committee. Other possibilities for the committee were discussed, but no one else has committed at this time. The committee will be looking for nominees for the whole slate of officers. Colleen will put out an email describing job duties so that anyone considering a position will know the duties of that position.

Minutes continued...

Possibility of starting a new drape and pole system for hanging quilts at the quilt show – It was discussed among the present board members and decided that this is something we want to pursue. Several people will start gathering information on systems and the cost before anything is decided. The possibility of using the money raised by the Online Auction to partially fund this was discussed.

Budget Changes – The board discussed a need for an increase in the property budget. It was moved by Diane Leighton and seconded by Linda Matsumoto to increase the property budget from \$250 to \$500 for the year. A unanimous vote to approve followed. After the budget was increased Linda Matsumoto moved and Diane Leighton seconded a motion to reimburse a member for the purchase of banker's boxes for storage of quilt show supplies. A unanimous vote to approve followed.

Vice Presidents Update:

March – is the quilt show wrap up. Pieces of Love quilt shop will present, and Jan A Thompson will share some of her quilts.

April – the speaker will be Kathy Allen

May - the speaker is Linda Schmidt and she will have a workshop following.

June - the speaker will be Pat Fryer with a Villa Rosa Trunk Show

Community Service: Collected \$300 for silent auction items at the Quilt Show

Opportunity Quilt: Was won by Angie Horne. \$589 worth of tickets were sold at the show.

Membership: We have 171 members including 2 junior members and 10 affiliates. We gained 8 new members and one new affiliate (Material Girlfriends) at the show!

Quilt Show 2022: Was a success! Current count is \$10,964.25 generated from the Quilt Show. It was noted that anyone needing reimbursement must turn their vouchers in to be paid by April 1. The exit surveys from the show indicated that the only negative was not being able to park in our regular lot.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 5:18 pm.

The next Board Meeting will be April 11, 2022 at 4 pm at Community Crossroads Church.
