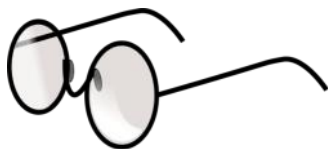


## Got Eyeglasses?

## Helpful Hints from Alyce

✓ Color the end of clear monofilament thread a dark color so it's easier to find. This also makes it easier to thread the needle.

✓ To eliminate creases in binding as you fold it, use an empty toilet tissue roll and roll the binding onto this. It's also easier when ironing it double. Just un-

wind as you iron. I also roll it back onto the empty roller after pressing. It's easier to handle when sewing onto the quilt edge.

✓ For cleaning an iron, use a dryer sheet or a ball of aluminum foil by rubbing the iron over them.

✓ Use metal hair clips to hold down the binding instead of

straight pins.

✓ For very pointed scissors, use pencil grips to protect the points.

✓ Use a suction cup with a hood on the side of the sewing machine to keep a small pair of scissors handy.

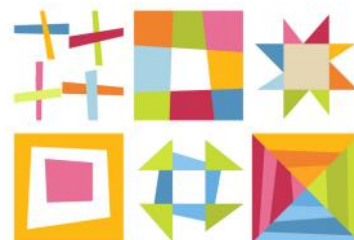



### **VALLEY QUILT GUILD BOARD MEETING**

**May 11, 2016**

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Cooky Amarel, Cheryl Gaines, Claire Poole, Wendy Cockrell, Linda Matsumoto, Margaret Rehmann, DeRay Jensen, Delaina Watson, Dee Jagerhorn, Carleen Hagen, Diane Leighton, Nancy Wilson, Diana Tatro, Joann Thomas, Jody Ohrt, and Shirley Jensen.

**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order at 12:05 pm by President Cooky Amarel.

**SECRETARY:** A motion was made and seconded (Watson/N.Wilson) and unanimously voted to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the April 13, 2016 Board Meeting. A motion was made and seconded (N.Wilson/Jagerhorn) and unanimously voted to accept the minutes as written. There was no correspondence.

**TREASURER:** The checking account has a balance of \$6,594.99 and the savings account has a balance of \$16,065.75.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Cooky thanked the nominating committee for their work in obtaining a full slate of officers for the 2016-2017 years. The election will be held at the May General Meeting.

Cooky inquired about the status of the Past Presidents pins. Wendy will check with a vendor she works with and see if we can obtain a discount if we order show pins from them for next years Quilt Show.

Cooky passed around a listing of past Quilt Shows. We are trying to complete the list of quilt makers, quilt winners, windsock makers, and pictures of Opportunity Quilts from past shows.

The revised By-Laws, Policies, and Job Duties have all been revised and are on the VQG website. Board Chairman and Committee Chairpersons need to print copies of the revised editions and place in their red binders before handing in their binders at the end of their terms.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Cooky reported that we will present the completed quilts to Casa de Esperanza at our June General Meeting.

Diane Leighton has approached the Yuba Sutter Mall about possibly using vacant storefront for a sew day or having quilt displays in the windows. More to follow on this subject.

Delaina has revised the Membership Form to reflect Junior Memberships. There is no cost for a Junior Members, Ages 10-18.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

Claire reported that there will be a presentation from five Guild members at the May General Meeting. Pamela Day will be the speaker at the June meeting. She only has one sign up for the purse workshop so we may need to cancel the class.

The Opportunity Quilt for 2017 has been quilted and they will begin selling tickets next week.

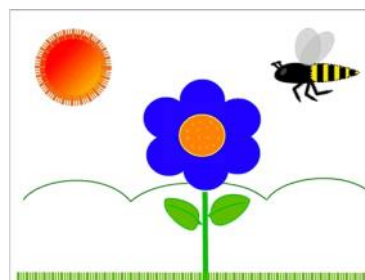

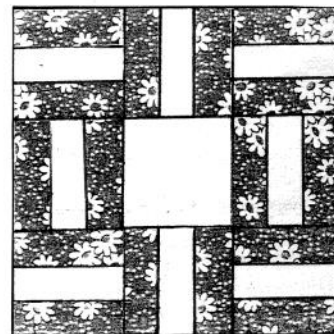

### BLOCK OF THE MONTH - BRING 1 OR MORE BLOCKS TO THE JUNE '98' MEETING

#### “BEGGAR’S BLOCK”

USE 100 % COTTON FABRIC, AND  $\frac{1}{4}$ " SEAM ALLOWANCES. SEW CAREFULLY, MEASURE TWICE, CUT ONCE!!! FINISHED BLOCK WILL MEASURE  $11\frac{3}{4}$  X  $11\frac{3}{4}$ ". THIS IS A 2 COLOR BLOCK USING MUSLIN AND YOUR CHOICE OF 30'S PRINT REPRODUCTION FABRIC.

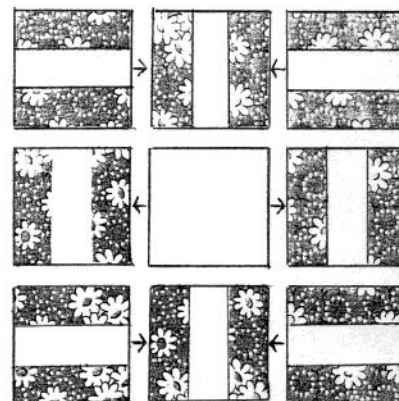
#### CUTTING/ SEWING:

- CUT 2 STRIPS OF 30'S PRINT FABRIC  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " X 44"
- CUT 1 STRIP OF MUSLIN FABRIC  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " X 44"
- CUT 1 MUSLIN SQUARE  $4\frac{1}{4}$ "

SEW THE 3 LONG SIDES OF THE STRIPS TOGETHER IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER - FABRIC/MUSLIN/FABRIC. GENTLY PRESS SEWN STRIPS TO AVOID DISTORTION. PRESS SEAMS TOWARD THE PRINT. CUT SEWN STRIPS INTO 8-  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " SQUARES.

#### ASSEMBLY:

LAYOUT, ASSEMBLE, AND SEW IN ORDER SHOWN IN DIAGRAM BELOW.
