### Fat Chance

Is your sewing thread old? Test by cutting off about 12 inches, then hold each end and tug hard on it. If it breaks, the thread is old, so discard. Even recently purchased thread can be old from the store's stock.

When ripping out a seam, only cut every 3rd or 4th stitch. Place a piece of masking tape on each side of fabric and pull.

Most of the little threads will be removed.

Batting wrinkled? Put it into the dryer for a few minutes and no more wrinkles. An alternate is to lay it out on a flat surface the night before using. Most wrinkles will be eliminated. **Note from Kim:** Don't leave it flat if you own a cat!

To prewash several small pieces of fabric at the same time, place them in a mesh lingerie bag and wash on the gentle cycle.


