Helpful Hints from Alyce



To use strips from the middle of a Jelly Roll but keep the rest neat, carefully unroll the strips and secure the ends. Ease out the

strips you want.



If you want to design a two-inch border, purchase a roll of adding machine tape as a guide, as it is two inches wide.



To make sure each block is the same size, cut out a piece of paper or cardboard the

correct size. Be sure to add 1/4" seam allowance on the outer edges. Lay block on the top of it. No paper should show. If too large, place paper on top of the block and adjust accordingly.



My To set dye in fabric, soak it in a sink of hot water with 1/4 cup of vinegar and an eye dropper of iodine. Let soak for at least an hour, then

rinse.



Tape a paper bag to the side of the sewing table to catch pieces of thread and fabric.

A meeting of the **Valley Quilt Guild Board** was held on May 11, 2020. It was an online meeting using the ZOOM application since the pandemic quarantine is still in effect. It was called to order at 4:04 p.m.

Secretary: A motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting was made by Eileen Milligan and seconded by Cooky Amarel. A unanimous vote followed.

Treasurer: VQG Treasurer Linda Novak reported that we have a checking balance of \$4,573.23 and a savings balance of \$15,137.14. Linda stated that she would like all expenses turned in by June 15, 2020 so that she can get checks written and close the books for the year.

Old Business: Quilt Show 2020 Treasurer, Pat Smith, asked that any outstanding raffle tickets be turned in. Terry Nugent said that she was giving \$50 in ticket sales to Thea Norum on May 12, 2020.

The stanchions which Cooky Amarel purchased will be reimbursed with Quilt Fair money, so they don't need to be included in next year's budget.

Nominating Committee: There were no further nominations for any of the executive offices, so the previously proposed slate of officers will be voted on as a group. The proposed voting by Good Form on the day of the May meeting was agreed upon by the Board.

Fair: Cooky Amarel said the Yuba-Sutter Fair was still on as planned.

Quilt Show Ribbons: Delaina Watson will be asked about the ribbons for the winning quilts and if she could put the names of the winners on them. Colleen Pelfrey will deliver them.

Zoom Sew Day/Mask Contest: 13 members have signed up for this virtual event using a Villa Rosa design.

Vice President Update: Michelle said Allison Jensen's schedule is flexible, but otherwise there are no changes to the lecture schedule.

Community Service: Rideout is keeping the rooms available for us.

Opportunity Quilt: Terry Nugent has volunteered to chair this committee.

Membership: There are 170 members in good standing as well as 9 affiliates.

UFO: On hold until the pandemic is over.

ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned at 5:13 p.m.


