Board Meeting Minutes

VALLEY QUILT GUILD BOARD MEETING May 9, 2022

Location: Crossroads Community Church

Date: May 9, 2022

Call to Order: A Meeting of the Valley Quilt Guild Board was held on May 9, 2022 at the Crossroads Community Church. It was called to order at 4:00 pm.

Secretary: A motion to approve the minutes of the April meeting as written was made by Linda Matsumoto and seconded by Deanna Williams. <u>A unanimous vote to approve followed.</u>

Correspondence: There was no correspondence this month.

Treasurer: We have a Checking balance of \$1,885.48 and a Savings balance of \$11,945.32. The Quilt Show balance is \$16,903.46 making our combined total \$30,734.26.

Old Business

Meeting Venues – May and June meetings are scheduled at Gray Avenue Church. Colleen will check with Carleen Hagen and if Cal Trans is not available will book July at Gray Avenue Church. Colleen has checked dates with the Presbyterian Church for the August Ice Cream Social and will complete the rest of the paperwork to confirm the event.

Nominating Committee Report- We have a full slate of officers to be voted on at the May general meeting. These are Carlene Raczynski and Sandy Parker, Co-Presidents; Deanna Williams, 1st Vice-President, Sandra Torres and Colleen Pelfrey, Co-2nd Vice-Presidents; Cathy Klaker, Secretary; and Jan A Thompson, Treasurer.

Purchase of new drape and pole system for hanging quilts at the quilt show – This is tabled until next month because we still did not have information on the system.

Fair – There were sign-ups for working the fair at the last general meeting and sign-up sheets will be available again at the May general meeting. Colleen will also put the sign-up sheets on Google to hopefully include some members that don't attend the regular meetings.

Addition of \$300 to the Community Service budget - Eileen Milligan moved and Pat Smith seconded a motion to increase this year's Community Service budget by \$300. A unanimous vote to approve followed. This reflects the money that Community Service earned with their Silent Auction donations at the Quilt Show.

New Business:

Retaining a CPA for answering questions about state and federal forms the treasurer needs to fill out for the guild – After some discussion establishing a need, Deanna Williams moved and Michelle Jones seconded to have a CPA on retainer for the 2022-2023 calendar year with \$300 being put into next year's budget to pay for possible consulting expenses. A unanimous vote to approve followed. The CPA will be Jerry Crippen, recommended by Diane Leighton because he has worked with our guild before.

Officers and chairpersons budget needs for the coming year - those in these positions need to look at their current budget and think about changes needed for the 2022-2023 budget. If you know of areas that need an increase or a change in their budget, please get the information to Colleen Pelfrey or Jan A Thompson.

E-mail address for the guild – we possibly have a comcast e-mail address. Jan A Thompson will talk to Terry Nugent (our current webmaster) about what we have and what we possibly need.

Possibility of a Group Facebook page for the guild – a discussion was held about starting a private Group Facebook page for guild members only to use as a platform for sharing a variety of things. Jan A Thompson and Cathy Klaker will look into the possibilities and logistics of doing this.

Ice Cream Social – the Ice Cream Social is a program so the planning falls on the 1st and 2nd VPs to do the planning for it. Deanna Williams and Colleen Pelfrey are fine with this and will do the planning.

Community Service Garage Sale – A garage sale was discussed and a motion was made by Leann Weldon and seconded by Jan A Thompson to approve a garage e sale organized by the Community Service team with the purpose of adding funds to the Community Service budget. A unanimous vote to approve followed. The garage sale will be on May 21 from 9am to 1pm at 1350 Delone Drive (Diane Leighton's house).

Reminder to submit any bills to be paid/reimbursed by the June meeting – this needs to be done to close out the 2021-2022 budget year.
