It's QUILT SHOW ENTRY TIME....Members, it's time to start thinking of what to enter in the 2021 Quilt Show "Dancing With The Stars". Covid 19 has changed our lives tremendously in the last 8 months and as quilters we've been adjusting our lives accordingly. The Quilt Show Committee has decided to proceed with the positive attitude we will have a 2021 Quilt Show. That being said, we are trying to keep Quilt Show expenditures down and have decided to go digital with the Quilt Show Entry forms. We hope to have it setup and online by the October Meeting; if not, the end of November. Colleen is assisting us with the new entry form format; she has been wearing many hats this year, and we are looking for a program that will meet our needs and can be accessed directly from our website so please be patient as we transition. Once it is online and ready to access the guild will send out a mass email with the updates and changes as they occur. I will have the carbonless entry forms available at my office after October 29<sup>th</sup>, Buttes Insurance Agency, 744 Bridge St., (corner of Bridge & Park Ave), Y.C. if you wish to stop by and pick them up you may do so. My office hours are normally Weekdays 9 to Noon and 1:30 to 5:00 p.m. (Friday's we close at 4:30). If you do not wish to come in, please call ahead and I can bring them out to your vehicle in our parking lot. 530-673-6860 / Pat.

If you entered your quilt in the 2020 Quilt Show, you may still enter it in the 2021 Quilt Show. You MAY NOT have that same quilt which was Judged for the 2020 Quilt Show, Judged again in the 2021 Quilt Show. Please remember you will need to provide the following information on your entry form whether you enter digitally or use the paper format.

- Quilt Name
- Quilt Size (accurate measurements)
- Made By and Quilted by
- Colors
- Interesting information regarding your quilt or textile exhibit.
   Photo

**Regular Quilt Entry:** Will require a completed entry form and photo of your quilt (we are hoping you will be able to upload your photo with the new digital format or it will have to be emailed separately).

**Judged Quilts:** Judged Quilts **ONLY** require a \$5.00 entry fee, and in addition to the Regular Entry form you are required to complete a separate Judged Entry form. (2 entry forms will be needed). Your entry fee will need to be mailed or dropped off at Buttes Insurance. **Judged Quilts ONLY** are to be delivered to the fairgrounds on Thursday, March 11<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.

#### **Dates to Remember:**

**Last date to accept Entries:** January 28<sup>th</sup>, at the General Meeting. (or date to be announced) **Delivery** of **Quilt Exhibits**: Friday, March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at the Y-S Fair Grounds, 8– **Entry #'s:** You must pickup your Entry Number(s) and labels which will be on a 3"x5" Card/

Entry #'s: You must pickup your Entry Number(s) and labels which will be on a 3"x5" Card/Receipt at the February 24<sup>th</sup>, VQG General Meeting. (Or delivery method to be announced) The number(s) needs to be put on your label, and the label needs to be sewn to the back of your quilt, in lower right hand corner. (If you are looking at the back of your quilt this would be the lower left corner) This Card/Receipt is also needed to claim your entry. Please do not throw it away.

**Pickup:** Quilts must be picked up after the show on 3/14/21, from 5-5:30 p.m. BRING YOUR CARD/RECEIPT.

Your entry does not have to be finished right now, but must be completed by the Quilt Show. Articles must be finished and in good condition. In order to have a new show each year, we ask that you not enter items previously shown in a VQG Show during the last 5 years. (2020 doesn't count) You **MUST** be a current VQG Member to exhibit in the show. Please limit your entries to 5 per member (if you have additional special quilts for display, please call Pat or Cooky.) Our Quilt Show this year will be held March 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at the Yuba-Sutter Fair Grounds. Give us a call if you have any questions.

A meeting of the **Valley Quilt Guild Board** was held on November 9, 2020. It was an online meeting using the ZOOM application since the pandemic quarantine is still in effect. It was called to order at 11:03 a.m.

**Secretary**: A motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting as corrected by Colleen Pelfrey was made by Diane Leighton and seconded by Carleen Hagen. The motion passed unanimously.

**Treasurer:** VQG Treasurer Janet Craver reported that we have a checking balance of \$2,085.44 and a savings balance of \$14,138.45. We have received a refund of \$550.00 from Whitaker Hall for the cancelled Christmas Party.

## Old Business:

**Virtual Christmas Party:** There was no update on Secret Santa because Terry was not in attendance. Colleen will check with her by phone or email. Colleen will be sending out a request for pictures of Christmas decorations or Christmas quilts for show and tell. Entertainment is taken care of by Colleen, Janell and Tammy. Colleen will put out a final call email for donations for our Christmas party charities. Challenge quilts will not be judged at the December meeting. Colleen is looking into the raffle to raise money to use for the Quilt Show raffle baskets.

"Let It Go" "Let it Go" has been let go for the time being. Colleen has been busy with the auction and may revisit it after the first of next year.

**Quilt Show Entries:** Colleen will be sending out directions by November 16. We will have 3 options, pick up an actual entry form from Pat May, download and print a form and mail it in with a picture, or fill in a form online, save it and email it to Cookie with a digital picture. We will send regular mail instructions to those guild members that don't have email.

Rally Up Online Auction: Auction is ready to go. We will mention that quilt sizes are accurate to within an inch measurement. The site will be updated to include the names of all members who donated items (unless the member wishes to remain anonymous). We will not state that all sales are final. The auction will be posted the day before bids can be made and will be open for bids from November 19, 2020 to November 29, 2020. (If you have places to advertise the auction Colleen will get you the links and the information earlier)

Explore Yuba Sutter: has been submitted, confirmed by the Appeal Democrat

**Grant:** The grant application previously discussed was not submitted because we did not fit the profile the grant people were looking for.

**Reciprocal Publicity agreements:** Colleen has made agreements with a couple of guilds to exchange publicity for online fundraising events.

## **New Business:**

**Opportunity Quilt Tickets** – We have sold almost our first 8,000 tickets. Eileen Milligan made a motion to purchase another 4,000 tickets. Deanna Williams seconded the motion and the motion was passed unanimously.

**Community Service:** Diane Leighton reported that the guild has many quilts to give and would like to donate some to foster care before Christmas. She and Colleen will figure out a time to photograph quilts and video the presentation get them picked up before the December meeting.

**Vice President's Updates:** Sandy Corbin is scheduled for February 24, 2021. The January meeting will be either a quilt show intensive meting or a slide show of International Quilt Show pictures provided by Colleen Pelfrey and Eileen Milligan.
