### Quilt Show Entries

**IT'S QUILT SHOW ENTRY TIME**....Members, it's time to pick up your entry forms for the 2020 **"Journeys" Quilt Show** at the October General Meeting. Please take a few moments to complete and bring them with you to the Nov/Dec. Christmas Dinner, on Wednesday December 4<sup>th</sup>.

As a reminder each entry is required to have a separate Entry Form, photo, and/or color swatches. Please also include **accurate sizes**.

Your Challenge project will also need an entry form, this is the only time where the size, description or a photo **is not** required.

**Judged Quilts:** Judged Quilts **ONLY** require a \$5.00 entry fee, and in addition to the Regular Entry form you are required to complete a separate Judged Entry form. (2 entry forms will be needed). **Judged Quilts ONLY** are to be delivered on Thursday, March 14<sup>th</sup>. Between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.

#### **Dates to Remember:**

Last date to accept Entries: January 29<sup>th</sup>, at the General Meeting.

**Delivery** of **Quilt Exhibits**: Friday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at the Y-S Fair Grounds, 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

Entry #'s: You must pick up your Entry Number(s) and labels which will be on a 3"x5" Card/Receipt at the February 26<sup>th</sup>, VQG General Meeting. The number needs to be put on your label, and the *label needs is to be sewn to the back of your quilt, in the lower left-hand corner.* 

This Card/Receipt is also needed to claim your entry. Please do not throw it away.

**Pickup:** Quilts must be picked up on 3/15/20, after the show from 5-5:30 p.m. BRING YOUR CARD/RECEIPT.

Your entry does not have to be finished right now, but must be completed by the Quilt Show. Articles must be finished and in good condition. In order to have a new show each year, we ask that you not enter items previously shown in a VQG Show during the last 5 years.

You **MUST** be a current VQG Member to exhibit in the show. Please limit your entries to 5 per member (if you have additional special quilts for display, please call Pat or Cooky.)

Our Quilt Show this year will be held March 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at the Yuba-Sutter Fair Grounds. Give us a call if you have any questions.

# Helpful Hints from Alyce



Rub fabric pieces together before purchasing to find out the amount of sizing used in it. A powdery residue means lots of sizing and pre-washing is recommended.



To keep templates together, paper-punch a small in one corner. Then put them on a shower hook. It will fit over a door knob or on a coat hanger for storage.



Need a certain size circle? Try using a saucer, dessert plate or lid off a can or container.



Mark a quilting design using a regular pencil, as it won't bleed, fade or disappear.

Pencil marks brush out easily if not too much pressure is used, and will wash out easily.



Instead of pencil line to mark fabric, try using a series of dots spaced closely together.
