## Helpful Hints from Alyce

Don't forget to wipe off your cutting board occasionally, as invisible dust accumulates on it. Cleaning the board also helps keep the rotary cutting blade sharp. Dust does dull the blade.

Put the pressure foot down when not sewing. This will reduce the pressure on the spring that holds it up.

Turn your ironing board around and set the iron on the smaller section. This gives you more ironing surface.

Still have a hot iron after taking a class or when sewing with a group? Carefully run cold water over the sole plate for a quick cooling. Thanks to Delaina Watson for this very helpful hint!

#### **September 11, 2017**

Call to order: A meeting of the Valley Quilt Guild Board was held at 519 D Street in Marysville on September 11, 2017. It was called to order by President Janell Willis at 4:08 pm.

**President remarks:** Janell welcomed everyone to the meeting. She stated that she had heard a lot of positive feedback about the Ice Cream social. It was a lot of fun and everyone seemed to have a great time. She thanked everyone who had a part in the evening.

**Secretary:** Billie Lindgren made a motion that the minutes from last month be accepted as written. The motion was seconded by Carleen Hagen. Unanimous vote to approve minutes.

**Treasurer:** Checking balance as of September 1, 2017 is \$9,586.30. Savings balance is \$16,070.02. Copies of approved budget were distributed to those attending.

#### Vice President:

In September we will have Sandra Bruce lecture and trunk show on September 27, class on 29th and 30<sup>th</sup>. There are currently openings for her class. Pattern is "Flying High."In February the speaker is Sherri McConnell. Her March 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> workshop is a Mahalo quilt. In April we have tentatively scheduled Anelie Belden. May is Ingrid Catanneo. In June is Diana Tatro.

You will have an opportunity at the September meeting to sign up for upcoming classes. We will also have a sign up for members that plan to attend the Sew Day so we can set up the right amount of tables.

#### **Committee Reports:**


